- Car number must be on the left side cage of the car.
- TRANSPONDERS - Transponders mandatory for scoring, if you do not have one they will be available for rent.  
 - Mounted on top/back side of cage, with the bottom of transponder facing up.
- ONE WAY RADIOS - All drivers must monitor race control on one-way radio 454.000.
- ALL CARS MUST ARRIVE WITH EMPTY TANKS. Fuel will be available from fuel truck directly to race car.  
 Fuel truck will be parked outside on dock only. No fuel additives allowed.
- PIT SPACES WILL BE 7'x9' when cars are unloaded. All equipment must fit in this space or be left outside!
- SAFETY ITEMS - SEE RULES FOR COMPLETE INFO - Helmets SA 2015/2020 • ALL DRIVERS REQUIRED to wear fire resistant underwear and one piece driving suit to cover arms, legs and body. - Suit must have SFI rating of 3.2A/5 or greater or FIA 8856-2000 or greater. - Nylon covered fire suits are prohibited.
- Head & Neck Devices Mandatory Rated SFI 38.1 • Seat Belts 2 Years from Date of Manufacturer at event.

### SAFETY RULE REMINDERS - (Check your safety equipment before arriving)

- ARM Restraints, Gloves, One-Way Radios are mandatory! One-way frequency 454.000

### SAFETY ITEMS - All Cars and drivers must comply with NJ State Safety Regulations.

#### A. DRIVER SAFETY EQUIPMENT

- ALL DRIVERS REQUIRED to wear fire resistant underwear and one piece driving suit to cover arms, legs and body.
- Suit must have **SFI rating of 3.2A/5** or greater or **FIA 8856-2000** or greater.
- **Nylon covered fire suits are prohibited.**
- Arm Restraints are Mandatory
- All Drivers Required to wear fire resistant gloves, shoes and socks.
- Steering wheels must have a padded center & quick release hub. No pull-pin.

#### B. HELMETS -

- All drivers must wear a properly secured full face helmet, which meets or exceeds the latest Snell SA Rating.
- The current snell rating is SA2020. Acceptable ratings include SA2105 and SA2020

#### C. HEAD AND NECK RESTRAINT -

- All drivers must wear a properly secured SFI 38.1 rated Head and Neck Restraint Device/System.
- Must have certification no more than 5 years old.

#### D. Rollbar/cage padding meeting SFI 45.1 Specs

- padding required anywhere a drivers helmet may come in contact with the rollbar/cage.

#### E. Rollover Bars -

- NJ State law requires a minimum distance of 3" between the top of the driver's helmet and the bottom of the roll bar measured at the closest point between the two with driver is seated and belted in place.
- A Halo will count for the measurement.

#### F. FULL CONTAINMENT SEATS - As per NJ State rules all competitors must have full containment seats with head and shoulders contained.

### SEAT BELTS - Must meet SFI Specification 16.1 rating as a minimum.

- A. Date of manufacture cannot be more than two (2) years old.
- B. Wrap around or bolt-in quick release five-point belt harness with all connections to be secured at frame.
- C. Shoulder harness must pass over a round bar located at the driver's shoulder height.
- D. No alterations to manufactured design.
- E. All belts must be in good condition and bear the date and manufacturer's name.

### RULE REMINDERS / UPDATES -

- **BOLT ON WEIGHT** - All bolt on weight must be painted white with car number.
  - Any weight not fully painted with a car number will be removed. No exceptions.
- **Slingshots must have New Jersey approved fuel tank developed by Richie Tobias! No plastic tanks!**
  - **For technical rules questions contact Speedway Entertainment / Rich Tobias.**
- **TIRE GRINDING** - Wet grinding only in designated area. (Windex / Simple Green)
  - No softening on premises. No chemicals of any kind permitted in the building.
- **LEAKING FLUIDS** - Make sure oil breather tanks are emptied and drain plug is closed! You will be blacked flagged for dripping.
- **ROUGH RIDING** - We will start the season where we left off. No rough riding! Considering this your first warning.
  - First offense in a race sends driver to JR Michalski Cool Down Zone; second offense car is sent to the pit area.
  - Officials have the right to park a car for the weekend at any point.
  - A car will be sent to the pits after a total of **TWO** unassisted cautions or rough riding calls.
